PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

SBR 44 is a zinc-free high molecular acrylic polymer formulation designed to clean and restore the “wet look” gloss to existing floor finish. Its excellent polishing and restoring ability removes surface marks, leaving floors conditioned, dry and spotless further prolonging the life of the finish. This highly concentrated, economical product can be diluted for application as both a spray buff and high speed restorer.

USES:

Suitable for use on most floor surfaces including vinyl composition tile, ceramic & quarry tile, terrazzo, concrete, and more.



DIRECTIONS FOR PRODUCT USE:

PURPOSE	DILUTIONS
 Spray Buff Polaco Rociado	1:8 (16 oz. per gallon of cold water) 1:8 (16 onzas cada galón de agua fría)
 High Speed Restorer Restaurador	1:4 (32 oz. per gallon of cold water) 1:4 (32 onzas cada galón de agua fría)



It is recommended that protective gloves and safety glasses be worn when using this and all cleaning products.

DIRECTIONS FOR SPRAY BUFF:



1. Sweep all floors.



2. For maximum results: start with a good base of 3-4 coats of a newly applied high solids floor finish. Let cure 24 hrs.



3. Per chart, prepare solution and apply using a sprayer.



4. Polish or buff with a spray buff pad. If a higher, wet look gloss is desired, re-buff with a fine polishing pad.

Note: Replace pad if it becomes too dirty or too moist.

DIRECTIONS FOR RESTORER:



1. Sweep all floors.



2. For maximum results: start with a good base of 3-4 coats of a newly applied high solids floor finish. Let cure 24 hrs.



3. Per chart, prepare solution and apply a thin coat using a clean, wet mop.



4. Allow mopped-on solution to be completely dry. Then polish using a burnishing pad.
