
DIRECTIONS FOR PRODUCT USE:

IMPORTANT: In order to do a good job of dust mopping, mopheads must be treated properly. The application of an excessive amount of treatment material can lead to dingy looking floors that will attract and hold soil readily. It may also be detrimental to certain flooring materials.

- 1. Pour or spray D-Dust full strength directly on mops or cloths, using enough solution to moisten thoroughly.
- 2. Allow treated articles at least 6 hours to dry before using.
- 3. To remove soil from treated articles, shake vigorously.
- 4. When too soiled for further use, launder and retreat.

It is recommended that protective gloves and safety glasses be worn when using this and all cleaning products.
